### Total Annual Fees and Charges

Incorporating tuition fees, year and subject level consumables, Student Accident Insurance, standard activities, excursions, camps and incidentals. Some subject electives may attract additional charges.

Payable in four equal instalments.

\*Year 12 fees are payable in three equal instalments.

### Application fee for future students

A non-refundable application fee of \$165 is payable to secure a place on the waiting list.

### Acceptance / Establishment fee

A non-refundable Acceptance / Establishment fee of \$1,000 is payable to accept a place and confirms the enrolment. The Establishment fee for Years 10, 11 and 12 is \$500.

### Sibling Discounts

Families with three or more children attending the College concurrently receive a 35% discount on the Total Fees and Charges for the third and subsequent enrolments.

### Annual Payment Discount

If the Total Annual Fee is paid by 16 January 2017, a discount will apply, please refer to the table above.

### College Service Scheme

Each family of the College can choose to contribute 20 hours per annum of voluntary work within the College, or pay \$688 per annum in addition to the Total Annual Fees and Charges. The hours contributed may vary year to year.

### Overseas Trips / Extra-curricular Activities

For students to participate in overseas trips and/or extra-curricular activities, all family tuition fees must be paid and up to date. The College reserves the right to refuse a student's participation in such events on the basis of unpaid family tuition fees.

### Payment of Fees and Charges

The first accounts for 2017 will be issued in mid-December 2016 and will be due for payment by 16 January 2017. Subsequent accounts, to be issued by 15 March, 15 June and 15 August, will be due for payment within 30 days of being issued (*due dates 18 April, 17 July and 15 September*).

Payments can be made by

- cash
- cheque (*made payable to Braemar College Ltd*)
- credit card (*Mastercard or Visa*)
- EFTPOS
- Direct Debit Authority (*application form available from the College*)
- BPay

### Late Payment / Overdue Accounts

The College may charge a late payment administration fee of \$35 per month to accounts that remain outstanding beyond the due date.

Payment of fees is still required where a student is absent from the College for any length of time.

The College reserves the right to suspend or cancel a student's enrolment for non-payment of school fees unless an approved payment arrangement has been made and is honoured.

### Notice of Withdrawal

Written notice of one full term must be provided to the Principal prior to the withdrawal of a student. Failure to provide the appropriate notice will result in one term of the total Per Term fee being charged.

### Conveyance Allowance

For 2017 the College will continue to support morning and afternoon bus transportation for all students.
